

## Jill Dietrich Mellon Named Alpha Gamma Delta Distinguished Citizen

[INDIANAPOLIS, August 9, 2022]— Jill Dietrich Mellon was one of four Alpha Gamma Delta members recognized as a Distinguished Citizen at the Fraternity's 51st International Convention in Louisville, Kentucky, on July 15. Almost 700 collegiate and alumnae members of Alpha Gamma Delta were in attendance.

Jill was selected as an Alpha Gamma Delta Distinguished Citizen in the field of public service. She earned a Bachelor of Arts in political science and psychology from Indiana University where she was initiated into the Beta Delta Chapter, and she received her Juris Doctorate and Master of Business Administration from Case Western Reserve University. She went on to serve as the Executive Director of the Dayton Veterans Affairs, and during her time there, she established the first-ever Dayton VA food pantry. Jill currently serves as the Executive Director of Northeast Ohio Healthcare System which provides care to over 112,000 veterans across 17 locations.

Jill previously served the Fraternity as Operations Advisor for Theta Omega Chapter at the University of South Carolina. She remains an active member through the Dayton Ohio Alumnae Club.

The Distinguished Citizen Award is presented each biennium to Alpha Gamma Delta alumnae who have made exceptional and outstanding contributions in their professions or in civic, organizational, cultural or charitable work. Alpha Gamma Delta was one of the first fraternity/sorority groups to honor alumnae in this way by establishing the Distinguished Citizen Award.
